The Teatro Colón is Buenos Aires' historic opera house and one of the most renowned in the world. Known for its extraordinary acoustics and grand architecture, it has been recognized by National Geographic as one of the ten best opera houses globally.

Hospital Alemán is a private, nonprofit, university-affiliated teaching hospital. It combines advanced clinical infrastructure with cutting-edge digital health initiatives. Hospital Alemán is funded primarily through its own private health plan (Plan Médico), patient out-of-pocket payments, and reimbursements from major obras sociales (employer-based plans) and private insurers. While it does not provide free care under Argentina's public health system, patients with only public coverage can access services by paying out-of-pocket. As a nonprofit institution, it reinvests revenue into clinical infrastructure, technology upgrades, and quality improvement rather than distributing profits. This mixed financing model allows the hospital to maintain international accreditation standards while offering advanced digital health and AI-driven services.
